UAE firms Enercap Holdings and Apex Investments have formed a joint-venture to build 16GWh per year supercap energy storage - which will host the largest capacity in the world.

As Abu Dhabi accelerates its transition to clean energy, factories are increasingly adopting photovoltaic (PV) energy storage systems to reduce costs and carbon footprints.

The facility will incorporate state-of-the-art technologies, including a virtual power plant with grid-forming capabilities and AI-driven energy management systems.

Revtterra's kinetic battery system, made using recycled steel, leverages rotational energy storage to provide high-speed EV charging, minimising environmental impact.

The joint venture is set to meet exponential growth in demand. This will currently be the largest supercap energy storage manufacturing capacity in the world.

By leveraging local innovation and manufacturing, the partnership aims to bolster the UAE's position in the global electric vehicle market and contribute to the country's industrial growth.
