Where should a locker be placed in a room?

When it comes to placing the locker, it must be placed in the right direction having at least one-inch distance with the wall. According to Vastu, locker must be a foot away from the North-west or south-west direction. If space is less in the room, go for east direction to fix the locker.

How to make a good locker room?

Make sure that the locker is not placed under the beam as it puts unnecessary pressure on it. Placing locker in any of the corners of the room is a strict no-no. The locker rooms should be free from clutter and mess. It should be extremely neat and clean.

Should a locker room be extended to a side?

How far away should a locker be from a wall?
