The country produces around 260 billion cubic meters (bcm) of natural gas annually, with 18 bcm allocated for export and the rest consumed domestically. Iran's gas demand has grown significantly, from 153 bcm in 2013 to 245 bcm in 2023, driven primarily by the residential sector, vehicles, and power plants.
